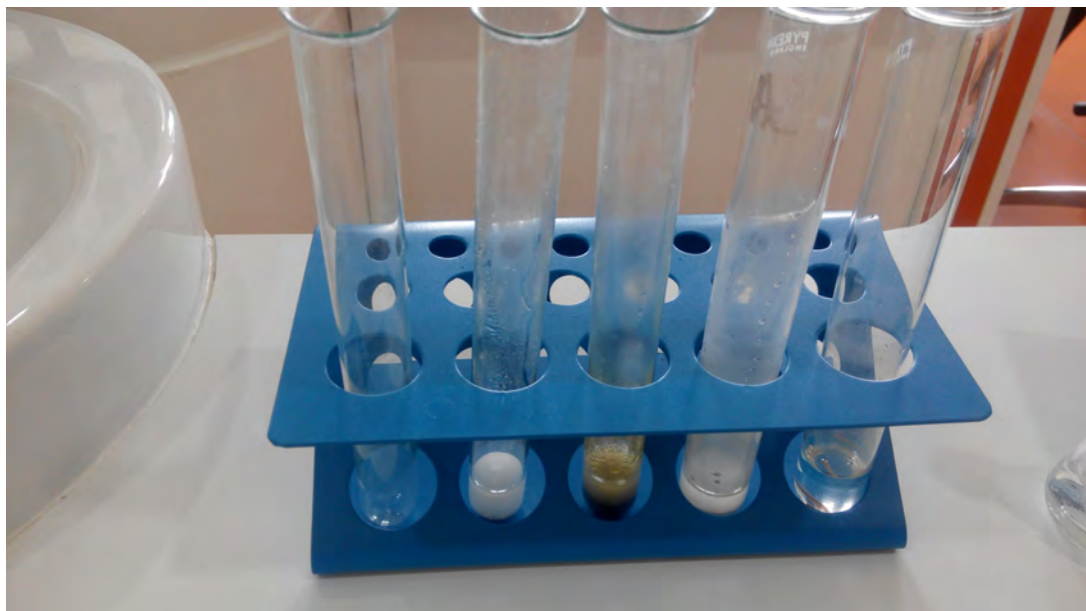

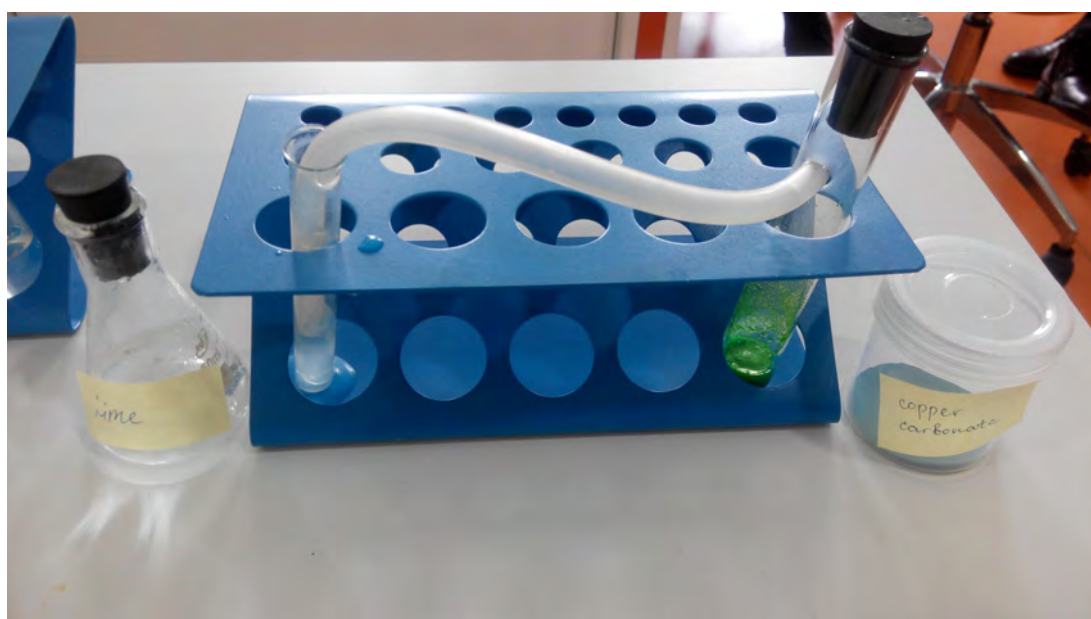

Reaction of metals with acids. Different metals like Aluminium, copper, Aluminium and zinc were reacted with Hydrochloric acid. The hydrogen gas formed was detected using the POP sound test.
